Proteena Bread Meal is a high energy, starch, sugar and oil-based feed source with valuable protein content.

The nutritional characteristics of Proteena Bread Meal are similar to wheat but with added sugar, oil and the additional benefit of gelatinisation of starch, giving it significant additional benefits.

It is fully processed, therefore no milling is required and no possibility of small grains to pass directly through to the lower digestive tract.

Both the starch and the sugar provide energy to drive rumen microbial growth and development, to stimulate the increase milk production as well as milk protein synthesis. These two forms of energy are also highly desirable inclusions for both feedlot cattle and pigs.



Proteena Bread Meal will also assist in the capture and utilisation of pasture nitrogen during periods of lush growth, since the added sugar in the Proteena Bread meal will provide an additional quick digesting energy source.



Feeding Guide

- For cattle, it can be utilised up to 30% of mixed ration but needs adequate effective fibre source to balance.
- For pigs, it is an excellent feedstuff with little restriction to use. In the high moisture form it can be effectively incorporated into liquid fed diets and even to replace the entire grain component.
- Shelf life needs to be considered when formulating rations.
